Why did Hitler launch the Munich Putsch?	He believed the government was distracted by the occupation of the Ruhr and the German people had had enough of the government
When did the Munich Putsch take place?	8 November 1923
Which respected army general supported Hitler during the Putsch?	Ludendorff

What crime was Hitler put on trial for?	Treason
How did Hitler take advantage of his trial?	He used it to publicise Nazi ideology as it was being reported in the newspapers
Where was he imprisoned?	Landsberg prison
What is the name of the book he wrote while in prison?	<i>Mein Kampf</i>
Since the Nazis were going to have to work within the democratic system, what did Hitler say they would have to do?	Hold their noses
How many seats did the Nazis secure in the 1924 Reichstag election?	32
What was the name of the personal bodyguard created by Hitler?	The SS
Who was the Nazi propaganda chief?	Josef Goebbels
How many members did the Nazi party have by 1928?	100,000
How many seats did the Nazis win in the 1928 Reichstag elections?	12
Which groups in German society had begun to support the Nazis?	Peasant farmers and the middle class
